

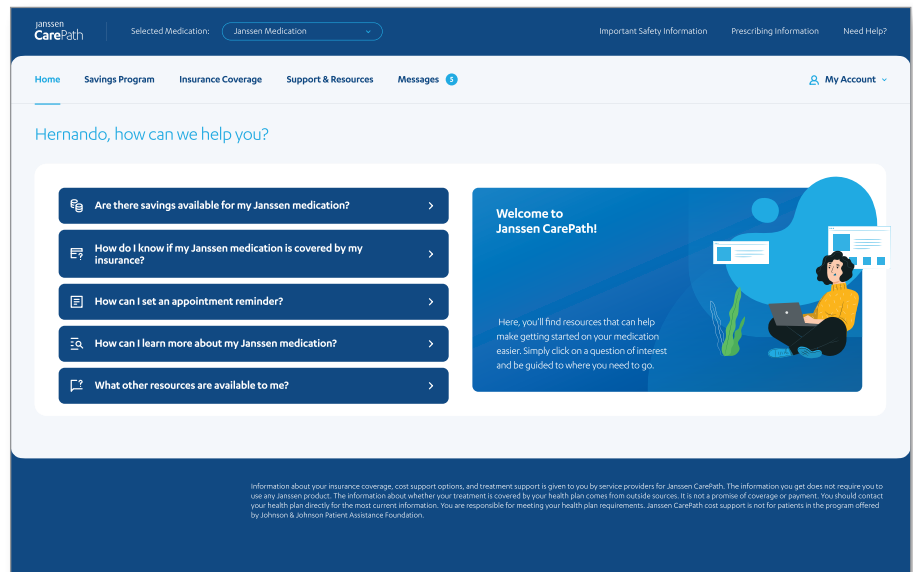
Your Janssen CarePath Account and How It Can Help You
