If you use commercial or private health insurance to pay for your Janssen medication



Eligible patients pay \$5 per infusion

\$26,000 maximum program benefit per calendar year. There is no income requirement. Terms expire at the end of each calendar year and may change. See program requirements at Rybrevant.JanssenCarePathSavings.com. Program does not cover costs to give you your infusion.

To determine eligibility, enroll in the Savings Program, submit Savings Program requests, and manage program benefits, you can create an online account at MyJanssenCarePath.com.

If you use government-funded healthcare programs like Medicare or Medicaid
