

Text Message Terms & Conditions

By opting in to receive text messages about Janssen CarePath (the “Program”), you consent to receive autodialed text messages on behalf of Johnson & Johnson Health Care Systems Inc. (“JJHCS”). You are not required to provide your permission to receive text messages to participate in the Program or to receive any other communications you have selected. You may unsubscribe from text messages at any time by replying STOP to any message you receive. A message will be sent to your mobile number confirming the cancellation, but no more text messages will be sent from this Program after that one, unless you opt in to receive text messages in the future.
