If you use commercial or private health insurance to pay for your medication



Eligible patients pay \$5 per infusion*

*\$20,000 maximum program benefit per calendar year. Not valid for patients using Medicare, Medicaid or other government-funded programs. See full eligibility requirements at JanssenCarePath.com.

If you use Medicare
