If you use commercial or private health insurance to pay for your medication



Eligible patients pay no more than \$10 per month*

*\$12,000 maximum program benefit per calendar year or one-year supply, whichever comes first. Not valid for patients using Medicare, Medicare Part D, Medicaid or other government-funded programs. See full eligibility requirements at JanssenCarePath.com.
